What personal data we collect and why we collect it

We use personal data collected through our website for the following reasons:

- To respond to your queries and to resolve complaints.

Contact forms

The information collected in any contact or enquiry forms will be collected and used for customer service purposes but won't be used for any marketing, or supplied to any third parties without user consent.

Subscription forms

The information collected in any email subscription form will be collected and used only for the newsletter subscription that the user has subscribed for. If the user changes their mind they will be able to unsubscribe by clicking on the 'unsubscribe' link at the bottom of the page. The information collected will not be supplied to any third parties.
